#### C. <u>Election Consultant Presentation</u>

Assistant Chief Barthelmass stated that he had researched several election consultants to assist in informing the public of the benefits of the \$0.34 tax increase and to also assist the Board to communicate its needs and the reason for the proposed tax increase effectively to the public.

Mr. Braxton Payne attended the meeting and made a presentation on behalf of his company, Show Me Victories, which had recently assisted several fire districts in the St. Louis area successfully pass recent tax increase. He reviewed his company's services and his proposed plan to assist the District. He also provided a fee agreement for review. He answered questions from the District.

A general discussion was held.

Following further discussion, Director Brown made a motion to approve the District entering into a consulting contract with Show Me Victories for the April 2025 election and the motion was seconded by Director Mathison.

#### B. Allenton Bridge Discussion

Assistant Chief Barthelmass presented to the Board the information that he had concerning the closing of the Allenton railroad bridge by MODoT due to the fact that the bridge failed its most recent inspection. It was reported that the bridge closure is going to increase response times by an additional 9 minutes to parts of the Legends, Ashton Woods, and out Hunters Ford and Wengler Roads. The Board expressed great concern over the bridge closure and increase in response times.

A general discussion was held.

#### C. <u>Health Insurance TPA</u>

Assistant Chief Barthelmass and Deputy Chief Stamberger requested permission to research locating a new third-party administrator for the District Health Plan. It was reported that the District's current TPA was sold and the level of customer service has declined. The proposal to conduct research and report back to the Board in January 2025.

A general discussion was held.

Following further discussion, Director Brown made a motion to approve researching a new TPA and the motion was seconded by Director Mathison.
